- CV

- Transcript of records
- Brief outline of a possible dissertation project (one page)
- Reference letter from a supervising professor

The professors of economics will propose one applicant for funding. The final decision is made by the board of the Dieter and Erika Schumburg Foundation.

FAU Erlangen-Nürnberg established the Dieter and Erika Schumburg Foundation in November 2009. One purpose of the foundation is to grant scholarships to excellent graduates of the Master of Science in Economics at FAU.
